IMPORTANT NOTES ON INSTALLING AND USING YOUR NEW MIRROR ARM & MIRROR

- Keep the mounting post lubricated
- Do not unscrew the mirror bolt, just loosen it
- Do not stand on the tower mirror as it can bend the tube and abuse is not covered under warranty
- Failure to tighten this can result in a lost mirror, which is not covered by warranty. Test this by pulling on the mirror each time before use.
- Note that this installation guide is only a guideline. Each boat is different and improvisation is needed to mount your Addict accessories on your boat.




INSTALLATION OF THE MIRROR TO THE MIRROR ARM

- 1. Loosen the mirror bolt from the mirror. Do not remove the bolt!!!
- 2. Push the mirror clamp over the mirror arm and adjust to the desired location. Use some soap to make this easier. Note: Do not remove the mirror bolt, just loosen it. The clamp goes in very tight when inserting.

INSTALLATION OF MIRROR ARM

- 1. Select a suitable location for your mirror arm, normally on the front right leg of your tower.
- 2. Remove two hex head cap screws (A) from mounting clamp.

 Split the clamp and place rubber ring (B) inside mounting clamp.



3. Place mounting clamp on tower and replace hex head cap screws (A). Snug the clamp for now so you can rotate it to the desired location, but tighten screws before using. It is important to tighten the screws evenly or clamp may bend, causing thread damage. A small gap between mounting clamp halves will remain when tightened properly.

Notice: Improper bolt torque could lead to poor performance or product failure.

It is the customer's responsibility to periodically check all bolts and screws to ensure that they are properly tightened. Improper tightening of bolts or screws can cause thread damage or product failure.

4. Loosen the handle (C) on the mirror arm and slide the mirror arm on the mounting clamp.



5. Adjust the nut on the back of handle (c) so the mirror arm is firmly attached on the clamp.

Care and Appearance

You can maintain the new appearance of your mirror mount by wiping with a clean damp cloth after each use. Soapy water or a commercially available marine water spot remover can be used as needed. Use only glass cleaner to clean the mirror face and occasionally wash the anodized aluminum.
